

# 2024 - 2025 NVC Women's Auxiliary Committee Scholarship Application

**Amount:** \$3,000

Prior to the establishment of the Women's Auxiliary Committee (WAC), the Nisei Veterans Committee (NVC) began as a "boys club" before evolving into the veteran, family, and community oriented organization it is today. According to former Women's Auxiliary member and lifetime NVC member, Louise Kashino Takisaki, the WAC supported the NVC men in, "...patriotic, social, charitable, educational, and public service within the community". Students interested in applying to this scholarship should be prepared to engage in a critical reflection in relation to community and service.

**Eligibility:** High school seniors, undergraduate, 4-year technical college, or graduate students. Applicants must be a resident of Washington State.
